IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (7-22) – Improvements to Interstate 630 will require overnight lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

A crew will improve the driving surface on the Interstate 630 railroad overpass between Woodrow Street and Battery Street or just west of Arkansas Children’s Hospital. The work will reduce Interstate 630 westbound traffic to two lanes (outside lane closed) within the work zone. It will also reduce Interstate 630 eastbound traffic to one lane (inside & center lanes closed) within the work zone.

The on ramps from Marshall, Battery and Woodrow Streets will require drivers to use caution while merging onto Interstate 630.
