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### **WORK REQUIRES TRAFFIC SHIFT ON INTERSTATE 40/430 INTERCHANGE IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (7-24)** – Construction work will require a traffic shift on the Interstate 40/430 Interchange in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The contractor is widening approximately 5.1 miles of Interstate 40 to three lanes in each direction, including widening two single-lane ramps to two lanes at the Interstate 40/430 Interchange. To continue with construction, traffic on the Interstate 430 north to Interstate 40 west ramp bridge will be relocated to the newly constructed inside lane pavement. Traffic will be controlled using a barrier wall and warning signs.

The transition will occur **Monday night, July 27<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday morning, July 28<sup>th</sup>, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.**, weather permitting. This configuration is expected to continue until interchange work is complete on the project.
