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BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES INTERSTATE 30 LANE CLOSURE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (8-7) – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on Interstate 30 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

A crew will inspect the bridge that spans railroad tracks between Roosevelt Road and the Interstate 30/530/440 interchange. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes on Interstate 30. This will reduce traffic to two lanes in each direction.

The closure will occur **Tuesday, August 11th** between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

The bridge was constructed in 1960 and reconstructed in 1980. It is 1,068 feet in length and 59 feet in width.
