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## BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES INTERSTATE 30 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

**LITTLE ROCK (8-14)** – A routine bridge inspection will require a lane closure on Interstate 30 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect the Interstate 30 bridge that's located over railroad tracks, between Roosevelt Road and the Interstate 30/440/530 interchange (mile marker 138). This work will require closing the Interstate 30 westbound outside lane within the work zone. This will reduce westbound traffic to 2 lanes.

The closure will occur **Monday, August 17<sup>th</sup>**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

This bridge was constructed in 1960. It is 1,068 feet long and 59 feet wide.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
