IMPROVEMENTS TO AIR FORCE BASE EXIT IN JACKSONVILLE REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES

LITTLE ROCK (8-21) – Improvements to the Little Rock Air Force Base exit (Exit 11) on U.S. Highway 67 next week will require overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be milling and profiling the intersection of Vandenberg Boulevard and State Highway 161 as well as the length of Vandenberg that stretches under U.S. Highway 67. Weather permitting, work will **begin at 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 26th and conclude by 5:00 a.m., Thursday, August 27th.**

The milled area will be paved the following week. Weather permitting, work will **begin at 7:00 p.m. Thursday, September 3rd and conclude by 5:00 a.m., Friday, September 4th.**

All work will require alternating lane closures as the work progresses. Traffic will be controlled using flashing arrow panels, traffic cones and flaggers.

Motorists are reminded to exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
