REPAIRS REQUIRE BRIDGE CLOSURE ON STATE HIGHWAY 187 IN CARROLL COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-11) – Work on the State Highway 187 bridge that crosses Leatherwood Creek in Carroll County will require temporary closure of the structure starting next week, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

It will take approximately six weeks to complete the necessary repairs. Beginning Monday, September 14, the following schedule will be in effect:

- **Mondays** – the bridge will be completely closed to traffic between 12:00 noon and 4:00 p.m.
- **Tuesdays through Thursdays** – the bridge will be completely closed to traffic between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

All work is weather permitting. The structure is located 1.5 miles south of Beaver.
