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### **IMPROVEMENTS TO I-430 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (9-4)** – Crews removing precast barrier walls and installing pavement markings on Interstate 430 requires overnight lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work requires alternately closing inside and outside lanes of southbound I-430 between mile markers 10 and 9. This work will restore southbound traffic to its normal configuration. The southbound I-430 lanes were shifted toward the outside shoulder between the Arkansas River Bridge and the State Highway 10 (Cantrell Road) interchange to construct an overhead sign and median barrier wall on I-430.

The lane closures will occur **nightly between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. starting Monday, October 5 and ending Friday, October 9**, weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled using barrels, electronic message boards and advance warning signs.

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 5.1 miles of I-40 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends east from Highway 365 to Interstate 430.
