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SOIL TESTING REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON I-30 FRONTAGE ROAD IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (10-9) – Crews taking soil samples will require lane closures on the Interstate 30 frontage road in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Work will require alternately closing the eastbound and westbound inside lanes of the frontage road within the work zone at the Roosevelt Road intersection. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and advance warning signs.

Weekday daily closures will be **Monday, October 12 through Friday, October 16 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

Weekend closures will be **Saturday, October 17 between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

This work is part of AHTD's proposed project to widen I-30 in Little Rock and North Little Rock between Interstate 40 and Interstate 530, including the Arkansas River Bridge, as well as improvements to I-40 from JFK Boulevard to Highway 67.
