## **Pavement Testing on U.S. Highway 67 Requires Lane Closures in Pulaski County**

**PULASKI COUNTY (11-19)** – Pavement testing on U.S. Highway 67 will require lane closures in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will alternately reduce U.S. Highway 67 northbound and southbound traffic to one lane, alternately closing the inside and outside lanes. The work extends from Main Street to Vandenberg Boulevard.

The lane closures already in affect from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** will end **Friday, November 20**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones, arrow boards and warning signs.

The work will reduce traffic to one lane within the work zone. Traffic will be controlled using advance warning signs, arrow boards, and traffic cones.

This project is in preparation for the future widening of U.S. Highway 67 between Jacksonville and Cabot. It's part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at [ConnectingArkansasProgram.com](http://ConnectingArkansasProgram.com).
