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Renovation Requires Lane Closure on Broadway Bridge (U.S. Highway 70)

LITTLE ROCK (1-14) – Renovation work at [Robinson Center Music Hall](#) will require lane closures on the Broadway Bridge (U.S. Highway 70) in Little Rock and North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The renovation work will require closing two lanes of the Broadway Bridge starting at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, January 15** and ending at **6:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 17**. During these closures both the northbound and southbound traffic will be reduced to one lane and shifted to the west side of the bridge.

On **Saturday, January 16 between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.** there will be a full closure of the Broadway Bridge. This temporary closure will allow the contractor for the remodeling of the Robinson Center Music Hall to remove the large tower crane used on the project.

Traffic will be controlled by signs, barricades, cones and police from North Little Rock and Little Rock.
