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High Water Prompts Delay to Maintenance on State Highway 178 Bridge (Bull Shoals Dam)

BAXTER COUNTY (1-11) – High water and cold weather prompted the U.S. Corps of Engineers to delay the maintenance work being done on Bull Shoals Dam and has put a halt to the continuing lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Lane Closures on State Highway 178 Bridge (Bull Shoals Dam) that were planned to continue through mid-2017 ended last week, allowing traffic to flow normally until the maintenance resumes.

The U.S. Corps of Engineers will resume this project when the water-level and weather allow, which may not be until mid-2016. For more information about this project, contact the Army Corps of Engineers Mountain Home Project Office at 870-425-2700.
