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### **Pavement Testing Requires Alternating Lane Closure on Interstate 30 in Little Rock**

**LITTLE ROCK (1-21)** – Pavement testing for future pavement rehabilitation requires alternating lane closure on I-30, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will consist of taking core samples from I-30, between 65<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 135) and the South Terminal. The lane closure will be conducted **daily between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.** starting on **Monday, January 25** and ending on **Thursday, January 28**. The lane closure will alternate between inside and outside lanes as well as between eastbound and westbound directions.

Traffic will be controlled by signs, cones and flaggers. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
