Improvements to Highways in Pope County Require Alternating Lane Closures

POPE COUNTY (5-20) – Improvements to multiple highways in Pope County will require alternating lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The alternating lane closures will occur from **8:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m.** beginning on **Monday, May 23** and ending **Thursday, June 9**, weather permitting. No work is anticipated for **Fridays, Saturdays** or **Sundays**. Traffic will be controlled using signage, flagging and traffic guides. The order of work is as listed below.

- State Highway 27 between Hector and Scottsville
- U.S. Highway 64 in Russellville, starting at Lake Front Drive and ending at the east end of the Illinois Bayou Bridge
- State Highway 326 in Russellville, starting at Lake Front Drive and State Highway and ending at Lake Front Drive and U.S. Highway 64
- State Highway 22 in Dardanelle, starting at State Highway 155 and ending at the Logan County Line
