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UPDATE!! **IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 40 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT** **LANE CLOSURES IN PULASKI COUNTY**

PULASKI COUNTY (6-3) – Asphalt replacement on existing westbound lanes of I-40 will require nightly lane closures in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

This work was previously scheduled for Tuesday, May 31, through Saturday, June 4, but was delayed due to weather.

The rescheduled work requires reducing westbound I-40 traffic to one lane **between 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. beginning Monday night, June 6 and ending Saturday morning, June 11**, weather permitting. The overnight lane closure will be between Highway 365 (Exit 142) and mile marker 146 to allow the contractor to replace existing asphalt surface in the center and right lanes.

Traffic will be controlled using barrels, electronic message boards and advance warning signs.

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 5.1 miles of I-40 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends east from Highway 365 to Interstate 430. The project is anticipated to be complete in mid 2016. More information on this \$38.4 million project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
