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Soil Testing on U.S. Highway 67/167 Requires a Moving Lane Closure in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (6-2) – Crews taking soil samples will require a lane closure on U.S. Highway 67/167 in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Work will require closing the inside lane of northbound U.S. Highway 67/167 within the work zone between Main Street (Exit 9) and Vandenberg Boulevard (Exit 11 – Air Force Base Exit). Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and advance warning signs.

The lane closure will be in affect **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., beginning Sunday, June 5 and ending Tuesday, June 7**, weather permitting.

This project is in preparation for the future widening of U.S. Highway 67 between Jacksonville and Cabot. It's part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com
