### **Maintenance Requires Temporary Overnight Lane Closures in Pulaski County**

**PULASKI COUNTY (6-3)** – Maintenance work in several areas of Pulaski County will require temporary, overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The overnight lane closures will occur nightly from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. starting on **Sunday, June 5** and ending **Thursday morning, June 9**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using signage and barrels.

- **Evening of June 5 through morning of June 6:** crews will be on Rodney Parham Road/Mississippi Street near I-630 performing profiling operations to remove bumps that have developed in the area.
- **Evening of June 6 through morning of June 7:** crews will be on Geyer Springs Road around I-30 resurfacing rough areas on the eastbound on and off ramps.
- **Evening of June 7 through morning of June 8:** crews will be resurfacing I-630 on and off ramps for Broadway Street.
- **Evening of June 8 through morning of June 9:** crews will continue operations on Rodney Parham Road/Mississippi Street near I-630, performing profiling operations to remove bumps that have developed in the area.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
