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Soil Testing on U.S. Highway 67/167 Requires a Lane Closure in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (6-10) – Crews taking soil samples will require a lane closure on U.S. Highway 67/167 in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Work will require closing the outside lane of northbound U.S. Highway 67/167 within the work zone between James Street (Exit 10) and Vandenberg Boulevard (Exit 11 – Air Force Base Exit). Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and advance warning signs.

The nightly lane closure will be in affect **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., beginning Tuesday night, June 14 and ending Friday morning, June 17**, weather permitting.

This project is in preparation for the future widening of U.S. Highway 67 between Jacksonville and Cabot. It's part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com
