Completion of New Railroad Overpass Prompts Traffic Shift on State Highway 226

CRAIGHEAD COUNTY (6-21) – Completion of a new railroad overpass requires a new traffic pattern in Craighead County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Eastbound traffic on State Highway 226 between Cash and Jonesboro will be moved onto the new eastbound lanes and the new railroad overpass at Gibson this week, weather permitting. Westbound traffic will also be moved onto the new railroad overpass.

This shift will occur on **Thursday, June 23**, weather permitting. The new pattern for traffic will limit westbound to one lane until the final paving is completed. Local traffic from State Highway 349 in this area will use State Highway 226 Spur for several days until this work is completed.
