Improvements to Interstate 430 Require Overnight Lane Closures in Pulaski County

PULASKI COUNTY (7-1) – Construction work on the I-430/I-30 interchange requires a series of overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The ramp carrying traffic from I-430 southbound to I-30 eastbound (Exit 129-A) will be closed between **10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 5 and Wednesday, July, 6.** Traffic will use the ramp as normal outside of the closure hours. This work was previously scheduled for Sunday, June 26 and Monday, June 27 but has been rescheduled due to the weather.

The closure only affects southbound I-430 traffic traveling to eastbound I-30. Motorists will be directed by signage to take Exit 128 on southbound I-430 and proceed onto the I-30 north service road in front of the Outlets of Little Rock and Bass Pro Shop. Eastbound I-30 traffic will then use the Mabelvale West Road Overpass and re-enter I-30 at the next entrance ramp. The attached map illustrates this detour route.

The exit ramp carrying traffic from southbound I-430 to westbound I-30 (Exit 129-B) will remain unaffected by this work.
