WORK REQUIRES RAMP CLOSURE, DETOUR ON LINDSEY ROAD IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (7-29) – Construction work will require temporary closure of the I-440 eastbound on-ramp from Lindsey Road, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be completing work in anticipation of moving traffic onto a temporary ramp. The work will require closure of the I-440 eastbound on-ramp from Lindsey Road. Motorists traveling Lindsey Road wishing to access I-440 eastbound will continue along Lindsey Road and then make a left at Fourche Dam Pike to enter the interstate highway. See attached map.

The ramp closure will occur **Tonight, July 29 beginning at 11:00 p.m.** The ramp closure and detour will remain in effect until work is complete Saturday morning at 6:00 a.m.


