Maintenance Work Requires Overnight Closure of a Section of U.S. Highway 64 in Cross County

CROSS COUNTY (8-26) – Repairs of the drainage system will require the overnight closure of a section of U.S. Highway 64 west of Parkin, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require closure of U.S. Highway 64 between Wynne and Parkin. Motorists traveling on U.S. Highway 64 will follow a detour.

- The eastbound detour route is State Highway 163 north to Birdeye, State Highway 42 east to Coldwater and then State Highway 75 south to U.S. Highway 64.
- The westbound detour route is State Highway 75 north to Coldwater, State Highway 42 west to Birdeye and then State Highway 163 south to U.S. Highway 64.

This closure will occur **Tuesday, August 30, beginning at 11:00 p.m. and ending Wednesday, August 31 at 5:00 a.m.**, weather permitting.
