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UPDATE! **Construction Requires Lane Closure on** **State Highway 112 in Benton County**

BENTON COUNTY (08-26) – Construction associated with the new U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass in Springdale requires daytime lane closures on State Highway 112, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

On **Tuesday, August 30 and Wednesday, August 31**, crews will be laying asphalt adjacent to State Highway 112 to widen the roadway. The lane closures will take place between **9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.**, weather permitting. Flaggers will maintain a single lane of traffic between Carrie Smith Road and West Miller Road during paving operations. This work was originally scheduled to begin Monday, August 29, but was delayed due to weather.

Advance warning signs will be placed to notify traffic approaching the work zone. The public is advised to be cautious if traveling in this work zone.

This project (Job CA0907) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and constructs approximately 4 miles of the new four-lane U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass, which extends from Interstate 49 to State Highway 112. The U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass project will provide a principal east-west route north of the Springdale Metropolitan Area.
