## 2016/17 ARKANSAS HIGHWAY MAPS NOW AVAILABLE

**LITTLE ROCK (10-5)** – The 2016 / 2017 Highway Map of Arkansas is now available from the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), according to Agency officials.

The map has been distributed free of charge to motorists everywhere since 1916 and are available at the AHTD Central Office, the 10 AHTD District Offices, and the Arkansas Welcome Centers. Orders can be placed online at the Department's construction and travel information web site [www.idrivearkansas.com](http://www.idrivearkansas.com). Phone orders are accepted by calling 501-569-2444.

Several hundred thousand paper maps are printed each year and feature the latest updates to the State Highway System (see attached list of data changes). No cosmetic changes were made to the map itself; however the cover photo does change for each edition and this year features State Highway 25 in Lawrence County.

The Highway Map of Arkansas also provides a close-up view of major cities in the state with expanded details on routes in urban areas. A convenient chart illustrates mileage between cities and towns. Public recreation areas are listed in directory format and include State Parks and historic memorials, National Park sites, National Forest recreation areas, and Corps of Engineers projects (parks).

### **STATE SIDE (Front Side)**

- Park & WMA boundaries have been updated.
- Index Panel: Population Change: Brookland.
- Pope County: Hwy. 124 from I-40 to Hwy. 7 has been removed.
- St Francis County: Added Federal Prison at Forrest City.
- Craighead County: (U.S. 49) to Crittenden Co. (I-55): U.S.63 renamed, level, and color to I-555.
- Perry County: Added Rose Creek community...added the name to the index
- Changed Bella Vista name to red.
- Benton County: Hwy. 12 widened to 4-lanes undivided (Job#090251) from Hwy. 71B to Shell Rd.
- Benton County: Hwy. 264 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#090284) from Hwy. 71B to Hwy. 265
- Benton County: Hwy. 264 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#BB0902)
- Independence County: Hwy. 167 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#050213) from Hwy. 394 to Antioch Rd.
- Independence County: Hwy. 167 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#050214) from Antioch Rd. to South city limits of Cave City.
- Van Buren County: Hwy. 65 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#080391) from County Rd. 28 to just N. of Bee Branch
- Cleveland and Dallas Counties: Hwy. 167 widened to 4 lanes divided (Job#070291) from the Saline River – South
- Lee and Phillips Counties: Hwy. 1 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#110217) from Walnut Corner to just south of Cypress Corner
- Craighead and Lawrence Counties: Hwy. 67 (divided) now open from Hwy. 226 to Walnut Ridge – exit numbers have been added (#111 at Hwy. 230 and #121A-B at US Hwy. 63)
- Independence and Lawrence Counties: Hwy. 67 and 67B has been renamed to State Hwy. 367 from the intersection of Hwy. 226 to Hoxie/Walnut Ridge - leave all Rock 'N' Roll Highway 67 text in place on the map - Minute Order 2009-069; Arkansas Act 497 of 2009 (House Bill 1837)
- Benton County: (Springdale) – Job CA0907 under construction line work between Hwy. 112 to I-49

- Benton County: Job CA0904 Bella Vista Bypass Hwy. 549 open (Hwy. 71B – Hwy. 72 South)
- Sebastian County: Hwy. 549 (Future I-49) added 2 ramp symbols and exit numbers (187, 190, 191, and 193), and 6 miles overall.
- Legend – State Corrections Institution is now Federal or State Corrections Institution

### CITY SIDE (Back Side)

- New city enlargement added – Bella Vista.
- Renamed, changed color and level to a portion of U.S. 63 to I-555 – Jonesboro check exit numbers.
- Hwy. 14 on the TX side of the Texarkana inset is not a divided hwy. Changed it to a solid black – Texarkana.
- County line – Russellville.
- Added the Old Mill at T.R. Pugh Memorial Park (Text & Boundary) place on the Little Rock city inset.
- Hwy. 12 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#090251) from the border to Hwy. 71B – Bentonville.
- Hwy. 264 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#090284) from Hwy. 71B to the border – Fayetteville / Springdale / Rogers inset.
- Hwy. 264 widened to 4 lanes undivided (Job#BB0902) Hwy. 264 INTCHNG IMPVTS. Fayetteville / Springdale / Rogers inset.
- Added the street name East Line Rd. along Hwy. 367 on the Searcy inset.
- Job CA0907 under construction line work from I-49 to the border of the inset. (Springdale) Fayetteville / Springdale / Rogers inset.
- Job 080397 under construction line work Hwy. 25 Relocation (I-40 North) Conway inset.
- Camden inset – U.S. Hwy. ramps changed to black.
- Job CA0904 Bella Vista Bypass Hwy. 549 open (Hwy. 71B – Hwy. 72 South) Bella Vista inset.
- U.S. Hwy 71 north of the Bella Vista Bypass was changed to a solid gray/outline in red. Bella Vista inset.
- Job CA0904 Bella Vista Bypass added to the Bentonville city inset.
- Pope Co. – Hwy. 124 has been dropped from I-40 to Hwy. 7 – Russellville inset.
- Updated the city limits of Gravette in the Bella Vista city inset.
