### **Maintenance Work Requires Moving Lane Closure on Interstate 430 in Little Rock**

**PULASKI COUNTY (8-31)** – Maintenance of the I-430 right of way will require a moving lane closure on I-430 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will treat areas near the wire rope safety fence with herbicide between Colonel Glenn Road (Exit 4) and the I-430 Arkansas River Bridge, requiring a moving lane closure on the inside lanes (both northbound and southbound).

This closure will occur **Wednesday, September 1, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.
