Construction Progress Requires Traffic Shift on Interstate 40 in Crittenden County

CRITTENDEN COUNTY (9-16) – Progress in the construction of two new bridges on I-40 west of West Memphis will require an overnight traffic shift, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

- I-40 eastbound traffic will be diverted onto the median detour portion of the bridge at mile marker 275.
- Traffic exiting I-40 eastbound at College Boulevard (Exit 275) needing access to Interstate 55 North will be detoured to U.S. Highway 64 east via College Boulevard north.
- Local Traffic leaving the neighborhoods south of I-40 traveling onto I-40 East will be directed east on the frontage road.
- Local Traffic leaving the neighborhoods south of I-40 traveling onto I-55 North will be directed west on the frontage road.

Please refer to the attached map. This shift will occur the evening of **Monday, September 19**, weather permitting.
