Improvements to U.S. Highway 70 (Broadway St.) Require Overnight Lane Closures in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (9-8) – Construction work on the U.S. Highway 70 (Broadway St.) requires overnight temporary lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

This work will occur from **Thursday September 8, 2016**, through **Friday September 16, 2016** from Second Street to I-630. The lane closures will be between the hours of **8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.** Traffic will be normal outside of the closure hours.

The closure only affects one lane at a time for pavement milling three to four nights, and asphalt replacement and striping operations for three to four nights. Motorists should be aware that uneven lanes may be present during both phases of construction. The lane closures will not affect use of the Broadway Bridge.
