### **Construction Work Requires Alternating Lane Closures on State Highway 4 in Desha County**

**DESHA COUNTY (9-14)** – Construction Work on State Highway 4 between McGehee and Arkansas City requires alternating lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

- Reconstruction will occur on sections of State Highway 4. A temporary traffic signal will be utilized and this will result in extended periods of one-way traffic. Usage will be intermittent, but frequent to allow both construction work and traffic access to the roadway.
- Resurfacing existing bridges and other sections of pavement will also cause intermittent one-way traffic on State Highway 4. No temporary traffic signals will be used for this work, but traffic will be controlled by flaggers.

These lane closures will begin **Wednesday, September 14**, and **continue through project completion**, which is expected to be **early 2017**, weather permitting.
