Construction Requires Overnight Ramp Closures, Detours and Traffic Shifts along Interstate 440 Work Zone

PULASKI COUNTY (10-3) – Construction work will require temporary closures of on and off ramps along the I-440 work zone and a traffic shift in the work zone itself, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

- **Monday, October 3, from 11 p.m. to 4 a.m.**
 - I-440 westbound off ramp to Bankhead Drive
- **Monday, October 3, from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.**
 - Fourche Dam Pike I-440 eastbound on ramp
- **Wednesday, October 5, from 9 p.m. until complete**
 - I-440 westbound traffic will shift from inside lane and shoulder to outside and middle lanes. **This will result in major delays to motorists traveling I-440 westbound until at least midnight.**

Detour maps have been attached for each of these closures. These closures will allow crews to make repairs to existing ramps and switch traffic to permanent ramps, weather permitting.




