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Construction on Highway 412 Northern Bypass Requires Highway 112 Lane Closure in Springdale

BENTON COUNTY (11-10) – Asphalt paving associated with the new U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass in Springdale requires a lane closure on State Highway 112, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Beginning **Tuesday, November 15**, crews will conduct paving operations that will eventually connect State Highway 112 with the new U.S. Highway 412 Bypass. Flaggers will maintain a single lane of traffic on State Highway 112 between Carrie Smith Road and West Miller Road during paving operations.

The lane closure will be daily from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

- **Tuesday, November 15 through Saturday, November 19**
- **Monday, November 21 through Tuesday, November 22.**

Advance warning signs will be placed to notify traffic approaching the work zone. The public is advised to be cautious if traveling in this work zone.

This project (Job CA0907) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and constructs approximately 4 miles of the new four-lane U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass, which extends from Interstate 49 to State Highway 112. The project will provide a principal east-west route north of the Springdale Metropolitan Area. More information on this \$100.6 million project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
