Arkansas Highway Commission Approves Bid for Improvements in Drew County

DREW COUNTY (9-14) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Drew County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

The purpose of this project is to pave 8.6 miles of the Monticello Bypass (U.S. Highway 69) and construct embankments at each end. The improvements will extend from U.S. Highway 425 to U.S. Highway 278.

Pine Bluff Sand & Gravel Company of Pine Bluff was awarded the contract at \$16,197,356.29.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in mid-2018.
