Construction on State Highway 102 Requires Overnight Lane Closures in Bentonville

BENTON COUNTY (01-10) – Construction work on State Highway 102 in Bentonville requires overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Beginning **Wednesday, January 11**, crews will perform bridge work on the State Highway 102 Bridge over Interstate 49. Westbound and eastbound lanes of State Highway 102 will alternately be closed to allow for construction, but one lane of traffic will always remain open. Traffic will be controlled using signage, barrels and flaggers.

Weather permitting, these lane closures will occur from **10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.**, from **Wednesday, January 11** through **Friday, January 20**, excluding the weekend.

This project (Job CA0902) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 3.5 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from Highway 62/102 to Highway 72 and includes constructing auxiliary lanes from Highway 62/102 toward Southeast Walton Boulevard.
