## **Construction to Close West Apple Blossom Avenue for 15-Minute Intervals in Lowell**

**BENTON COUNTY (4-17)** – Crews placing steel bridge beams associated with constructing the U.S. Highway 412 Bypass will require closing all lanes on West Apple blossom Avenue in Lowell for multiple 15-minute periods, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The intermittent closures began April 11 and will continue **through Thursday, April 20 for 15-minute periods between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.**, weather permitting. Eastbound and westbound traffic will be stopped between South Goad Springs Road and Kinkade Place.

Traffic will be controlled using signage and flaggers. The public is advised to be cautious if traveling in this work zone.

This project (Job CA0907) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and constructs approximately 4 miles of the new four-lane U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass, which extends from Interstate 49 to State Highway 112. The U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass project will provide a principal east-west route north of the Springdale Metropolitan Area.
