Improvements Require Traffic Shift and Lane Closures on U.S. Highway 67/167 in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (4-7) – Construction on U.S. Highway 67/167 in Jacksonville requires a traffic shift onto the new construction and lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Weather permitting, alternating lane closures will occur from **9:00 p.m.** on **Monday, April 10** through **7:00 a.m.** on **Tuesday, April 11**. This will allow crews to shift northbound traffic from existing lanes onto the newly constructed lanes of U.S. Highway 67/167.

Southbound traffic of U.S. Highway 67/167 will not be affected by either the closures or the traffic shift.
