Improvements to U.S. Highway 67 Require Traffic Shift in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (8-1) – Construction work to U.S. Highway 67 requires a traffic shift in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; northbound traffic on U.S. Highway 67 will be temporarily reduced to one lane between **9:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, August 2**, and **6:00 a.m.** on **Thursday, August 3**, to allow for the opening of the Redmond Rd. exit ramp and the closure of the Main St. Exit ramp.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
