Utility Work on State Highway 7 Requires Temporary Lane Closures in Hot Springs

GARLAND COUNTY (8-3) - Utility Work by AT&T requires temporary, overnight lane closures on State Highway 7 in Hot Springs, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; AT&T will close the inside northbound lane of State Highway 7 at Prospect Ave from **12:00 a.m.** to **7:00 a.m.** on **Monday, August 7** and **Tuesday, August 8.**

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
