Maintenance Work Requires Overnight Lane Closures on Interstate 630 in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (8-7) – Maintenance work on a railroad overpass across I-630 requires an overnight lane closure in Little Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; I-630 will have both outside lanes closed between Dr. M.L.K. Jr Dr. (Exit 2B) and Woodrow St. (Exit 3A) from **7:00 p.m.** to **5:30 a.m.** on **Monday, August 7.** The on-ramp to I-630 from Dr. M.L.K. Jr Dr. will be in a yield condition.

Traffic will be controlled with flagger, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
