Routine Inspection on Interstate 30 Bridges over Rail Road Tracks Requires Lane Closures in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (8-14) – A routine inspection of the I-30 bridges where they cross over the rail road tracks just north of the South Terminal Interchange requires lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

The following lane closures will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

- On **Wednesday, August 16** the outside eastbound lane will be closed between mile markers 138 and 139.
- On **Thursday, August 17** the outside westbound lane will be closed between mile markers 138 and 139.

Traffic will be controlled with flagger, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
