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Construction Requires Lane Closures on Interstate 49 in Rogers

BENTON COUNTY (10-02) – Bridge construction on Interstate 49 in Rogers requires nighttime lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Beginning **Wednesday night, October 4**, crews will be performing construction on the I-49 bridge over New Hope Road at Exit 83. The center and outside lanes of northbound traffic will be closed overnight. Weather permitting; these closures will occur nightly between **9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.** from **Wednesday, October 4 through Friday, October 6**.

Traffic will be controlled using signage and traffic barrels.

This project (Job CA0901) is part of ArDOT's Connecting Arkansas Program and included widening 5 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from State Highway 264 in Lowell to New Hope Road in Rogers. More information on this \$38.7 million project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
