Pavement Testing on Interstate 40 Requires Alternating Lane Closures in Lonoke County

LONOKE COUNTY (10-20) – Testing of I-40 pavement requires alternating lane closures on I-40 in Lonoke County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; on **Monday, October 23** crews will close a single east or west bound lane at a time, alternating which lane, between mile markers 163 and 175 from **8:30 a.m.** to **4:30 p.m.**

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
