Routine Bridge Inspections on Interstate 30 Requires Temporary Lane Closures

CLARK COUNTY (9-25) – Routine bridge inspections on Interstate 30 require temporary lane closures in Clark County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting;

- Between **8:00 a.m.** and **12:00 p.m.** on **Monday, October 23** crews will close the outside eastbound lane between mile markers 61 and 65.
- Between **8:00 a.m.** and **12:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, October 24** crews will close the outside eastbound lane between mile markers 67 and 71.
- Between **8:00 a.m.** and **12:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, October 25** crews will close the outside eastbound lane between mile markers 69 and 72.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
