Improvements to State Highway 226 Require Lane Closures in Jonesboro

CRAIGHEAD COUNTY (10-25) - Construction work to improve State Highway 226 (Woodsprings Rd.) in Jonesboro will require lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will be performing asphalt work that will alternately close a single lane of traffic on State Highway 226 between the city limits of Jonesboro and U.S. Highway 63 starting on, **Friday, October 27 at 7:00 a.m.** Lane closures will occur weekdays from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** until the project is complete, which is estimated to be 1 week.

Traffic will be controlled by signage, flaggers and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
