Paving Requires Alternating Lane Closures on State Highway 10 Motorists Encouraged to Seek Alternate Routes

PULASKI COUNTY (11-1) – Work related to construction of a new Interstate 430 northbound on-ramp will require lane closures on State Highway 10 in West Little Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation officials.

State Highway 10 (Cantrell Road) will have alternating lane closures in the vicinity of the I-430 interchange to allow the contractor to conduct asphalt paving operations. Work will impact **both the east and westbound lanes** and the closures will alternate between the inside and outside lanes. **Weather permitting**, lane closures will be extended through:

Monday, October 30 through **Saturday, November 4**

Westbound: 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Eastbound: 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect delays in the project area and are advised to consult the Department's traveler information site [IDrive Arkansas](http://IDriveArkansas.com). An alternate route is highly recommended.

Traffic will be controlled by signage, message boards and traffic drums. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
