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Work Requires Alternating Lane Closures on U.S. Highway 67 in Saline County

SALINE COUNTY (10-27) – Work related to pavement preservation on U.S. Highway 67 in Saline County will begin tomorrow, Saturday October 28 at 7:00 a.m., and will require lanes in both directions to be alternately closed, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation officials.

Weather permitting; the contractor will begin milling the existing asphalt pavement in preparation for placement of a new asphalt layer between Exit 114 at Interstate 30 and the Hot Spring County line.

Random alternating lane closures will occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily for at least 21 days while the contractor completes the work.

Motorists are encouraged to be aware of slow-moving traffic and potential delays as work is performed on the route. Traffic will be controlled by warning signs and flaggers.
