Bridge Repairs Require Lane Closures on Interstate 55 in Mississippi County

MISSISSIPPI COUNTY (11-9) – Repairs to the Mississippi County Road 410 Overpass will require lane closures on I-55 in Mississippi County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Crews will close the outside northbound lane of I-55 starting on **Monday, November 13** until further notice while permanent repairs are made.

On **Wednesday, November 15** both northbound lanes will be closed for up to 6 hours while the new beam is placed. During this time northbound I-55 traffic will be detoured to State Highway 148 (Exit 57, close to Burdette) to U.S. Highway 61, ending at U.S. Highway 61 and I-55 in Blytheville. Once the beam is secured, one of the northbound lanes will be reopened to traffic.

Southbound I-55 traffic will not be impacted during this time.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
