Utility Work on State Highway 9 Requires Alternating Lane Closures in Hot Spring County

HOT SPRING COUNTY (11-7) – Utility Work by a CenterPoint Energy contractor requires closing the southbound lane of State Highway 9 just north of Lono, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; on **Tuesday, November 7** and **Wednesday, November 8** the southbound lane will be closed on State Highway 9 at Sulphur Springs Rd. (County Road 61) from **9:00 a.m.** to **3:00 p.m.**

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
