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Construction to Close Interstate 49 On-Ramp for 15-minute Intervals in Fayetteville

WASHINGTON COUNTY (11-9) – Crews completing concrete sealing on the ramp from State Highway 112 to northbound I-49 in Fayetteville will require closing the on-ramp for multiple 15-minute intervals, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; workers will close the lanes for 15-minute intervals between **11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.**, on **Monday night, November 13**. Traffic using the State Highway 112 to northbound I-49 ramp at Exit 66 may be impacted during the closures and should consider alternate routes.

In August 2016, the Arkansas Highway Commission awarded a contract in the amount of \$94,824,907.70 to Kiewit Infrastructure South Co., of Fort Worth, TX, for the project. This project will widen I-49 to three lanes in each direction and make improvements to the State Highway 112 (Exit 66) Interchange.
