Improvements on Interstate 40 Require Alternating Overnight Lane Closures near West Memphis

CRAIGHEAD COUNTY (11-17) - Installation of Weigh-In-Motion hardware will require alternating, overnight lane closures just east of West Memphis, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will alternately close I-40 westbound lanes to install updated weigh-in-motion hardware between mile markers 283 and 284, just east of West Memphis at the Riverside Weigh Station. These closures will occur nightly from **8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** starting on **Saturday, November 18** and continuing through **Tuesday, November 21**.

Traffic will be controlled by signage and traffic drums. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
