Improvements Requires Closures on State Highway 361 in Black Rock

LAWRENCE COUNTY (11-27) – Replacing a drainage structure on State Highway 361 (N. Fourth St.) at Lawrence County Road 222 requires closures and detours in Black Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; State Highway 361 at Lawrence County Road 222 will be closed to thru traffic starting on **Tuesday, November 28** through **Wednesday, November 29**. Local traffic should use local roads, county and city, to avoid the work zone. All large trucks and vehicles should use U.S. Highway 62 or U.S. Highway 67 as an alternate route.

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
