Replacement of Traffic Sensors to Require Lane Closures on Interstate 30 in Clark County

CLARK COUNTY (12-1) – Crews replacing sensors in a traffic box on Interstate 30 near Arkadelphia will require lane closures next week, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

On **Tuesday, December 5**, crews will close the eastbound, outside lane of Interstate 30 between Mile Markers 74 and 76 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. On **Wednesday, December 6**, the eastbound, inside lane will be closed at the same location between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weather permitting.
