### **Routine Bridge Inspection on Interstate 30 Requires Temporary Lane Closures**

**CLARK COUNTY (12-18)** – Routine bridge inspection on Interstate 30 requires temporary lane closures near Gum Springs, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting;

- between **8:00 a.m.** and **4:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, December 19** crews will close the outside westbound lane between mile markers 67 and 72 to inspect the bridges over Big Decipher Creek and Little Decipher Creek
- between **8:00 a.m.** and **12:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, December 20** crews will close the outside eastbound lane between mile markers 65 and 68 to inspect the bridge over Mill Creek.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
